

Medicare-Two Reasons for EDI Enrollment Form Rejections

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Group PTAN and NPI Numbers are Required for All Electronic Claim and Remit Requests

When completing EDI enrollment forms for Part B providers, the group PTAN and numbers are required on all EDI enrollment applications. Medicare processes claims based on the group information for Part B. If you are a member of a group, the submission of the individuals' PTAN/NPI numbers are not required, **only** the group.

All EDI enrollment forms are required to be completed by the provider. The forms require an electronic signature by the authorized or delegated official for the provider group.

Provider's Name Received on Agreement Does Not Match the Medicare Database

When completing the EDI enrollment forms, the name listed on the forms for the provider must be the same name that was enrolled in the Medicare Program on the 855 application.

If the provider is part of a group, the forms must contain the name of the group, not the individual member.
